"Virgil Cimosoş takes up, almost first, the challenge of analysing my entire debate with Derrida, devoted to the mimetic relation between (my supposed) "negative theology" and (the fleeting) "deconstruction". He shows that what I mean by de-nomination "does not reduce itself to a new form of de-negation" but extracts language from the regime of predication in the direction of a talk about (*à*), possibly about God (*À-Dieu*). The "absence"

of God as the object of predication thus becomes the world, the space and the very condition of his invocation. The fact that it inscribes my reflection in that of Father Scrima constitutes the strongest legitimacy I could have hoped for from this study" (*Jean-Luc Marion.
