

# AGREEMENT

between the

“George Baritiu” History Institute of the Romanian Academy Cluj-Napoca Branch, Cluj-Napoca, 400084. Str. M. Kogălniceanu nr. 12-14, Romania, represented by its director, Corresponding Member of the Romanian Academy Professor Ioan Bolovan,

and the

State of Baden-Württemberg,  
represented by the Ministry of the Interior, Digitalisation and Local Government Baden-Wuerttemberg, represented by the Institute for Cultural Analysis of Germans of Eastern Europa, Goethestr. 63, 79100 Freiburg, Federal Republic of Germany, represented by its managing director Dr. Tilman Kasten

## 1.

Based on the successful cooperation between the “George Baritiu” History Institute of the Romanian Academy Cluj-Napoca Branch and the Institute for Cultural Analysis of Germans of Eastern Europe in the past, and motivated by the mutual desire to expand this cooperation and deepen mutual relations, the two institutions have agreed to conclude a framework agreement. This agreement will form the basis for future cooperation between the two institutions.

## 2.

The framework agreement aims to foster scientific exchange and intensify cooperation in the fields of European Ethnology and Cultural Analysis. The focus is on the German-speaking population in East Central Europe and their relations with the multinational context of the region.

## 3.

The person responsible for implementing the cooperation agreement on behalf of the “George Baritiu” History Institute of the Romanian Academy Cluj-Napoca Branch is Dr. Corneliu Pintilescu, and on behalf of the Institute for Cultural Analysis of Germans of Eastern Europe Dr. Tilman Kasten.

**4.**

The cooperation covers the following areas:

- Implementation of joint projects and research initiatives
- Organization and hosting of conferences and workshops
- Publications
- Exchange of researchers and students

This agreement does not imply any mutual financial obligations. Separate agreements will be made for any activities involving financial obligations within the framework of this cooperation, taking into account the specific requirements and conditions of each activity.

**5.**


Changes to the framework agreement can only be made by mutual consent and must be recorded in writing.


**6.**

The framework agreement is initially concluded for a period of five years. It can be terminated in writing by both cooperation partners at any time. The framework agreement is automatically extended for a further year after five years, provided that it is not terminated before the end of the five-year period.

**7.**

The framework agreement shall enter into force upon signature by both parties.
