

**AGREEMENT OF COOPERATION  
BETWEEN  
THE "GEORGE BARIȚIU" INSTITUTE OF HISTORY IN CLUJ-NAPOCA  
AND  
THE MARIA CURIE-SKŁODOWSKA UNIVERSITY IN LUBLIN  
THE INSTITUTE OF HISTORY**

This AGREEMENT OF COOPERATION was implemented on 4th February 2025

BETWEEN

THE "GEORGE BARIȚIU" INSTITUTE OF HISTORY IN CLUJ-NAPOCA,  
Kogălniceanu Street No. 12-14, 400088, Cluj-Napoca, **Romania**, as FIRST PARTY

AND

THE MARIA CURIE-SKŁODOWSKA UNIVERSITY IN LUBLIN, THE INSTITUTE OF  
HISTORY, Pl. M. Curie-Skłodowskiej 5, 20-031 Lublin, **Poland**, as SECOND PARTY or  
UMCS.

The following has been agreed between the "George Barițiu" Institute of History in Cluj-Napoca, Romania, represented by Ioan BOLOVAN, PhD, Director, and the Institute of History of the Maria Curie-Skłodowska University in Lublin, Poland, represented by prof. Radosław Dobrowolski, Rector.

I. The aim of cooperation is:

1. To strengthen and to develop the scientific contacts between the abovementioned parties.
2. To promote research and exploration of the social, cultural, and political history of Romania and Poland, the Romanian-Polish historical relations and links from the Middle Ages until the recent period.
3. To elaborate and develop joined research projects in the frame of agreement between the abovementioned parties, and in the frame of other present or future funding grants provided by public and private organizations.
4. To promote the understanding of historical and cultural issues and traditions of our parties.

II. To achieve these goals, the "George Barițiu" Institute of History in Cluj-Napoca, and the Institute of History at the Maria Curie-Skłodowska University in Lublin agree to develop their scientific cooperation in a specific manner, to:

1. Develop mutual institutional academic exchanges by inviting scholars for research activities.
2. Provide mutual assistance and advising on archive funds and libraries for research purposes, scholarly consultations.
3. Exchange informations concerning the development of research in each country, involving publications, academic journals, conferences, workshops.


4. Cooperate in refereeing and reviewing journals, monographs, and academic editions.
  5. Elaborate in partnership academic editions of historical documents concerning the common Romanian-Polish history;
  6. Mutually participate in editorial boards of academic journals and review committees;
  7. Organize joined conferences, round tables and workshops;
  8. Employee exchange;
  9. Other actions agreed by the parties.
- III. While this agreement does not commit either party to financial outlays, both parties will seek funding to support activities developed under this agreement.
- IV. Unless it is agreed upon specifically, the host Institution will have no financial responsibility for any expenses incurred regarding the abovementioned activities and any other than those expressly provided for.
- V. The implementation of this agreement will be supervised by:
- 1) from UMCS website: The Institute of History At The Maria Curie-Sklodowska University,
  - 2) from First Party: The „George Barițiu” Institute of History in Cluj-Napoca,
- VI. This Agreement shall enter into force upon signature by both Parties.
- VII. The agreement is valid for five years from the date of signature by the last party, unless either party requests its cancellation no later than six months before the end of the calendar year.
