AGREEMENT

1.

Based on the good cooperation between the "George Baritiu" Institute of History and the Institute of Danube Swabian History and Regional Studies in the past and driven by the mutual desire to expand cooperation and deepen mutual relations, the two institutions agree to conclude a framework agreement. This will form the basis for future cooperation between the two institutions.

2.

The framework agreement aims to promote academic exchange and intensify cooperation in the fields of history, political science, ethnology, literature and language. The focus is on the German-speaking population in South-East and East-Central Europe, their relations with the multinational environment of the region and the exchange between South-East and East-Central Europe and the German-speaking area of Central Europe.

3.

Responsible for the implementation of the cooperation agreement on the part of the "George Baritiu" Institute of History (cooperation partner) is PD Dr. Ottmar Trașcă and on the part of the Institute for Danube-Swabian History and Regional Studies the managing director and deputy director PD Dr Daniela Simon.

4.

The co-operation includes the following areas:

- Realisation of joint projects and research projects
- Organisation and holding of conferences and workshops
- Issuing of publications
- Exchange of books, researchers and students

5.

Changes to the framework agreement can only be made by mutual agreement and must be recorded in writing.

6.

There will be no financial obligations for neither of the parties by signing this agreement.

7.

The framework agreement is initially concluded for a period of five years. It can be cancelled in writing by either cooperation partner at any time. The framework agreement is automatically extended by a further year after five years unless it is cancelled before the end of the five-year period.

8.

The framework agreement is issued in German, Romanian and English and comes into force upon signature.
